Emergency Food: Trussell Trust Food Banks

You need a voucher to get food from Trussell Trust food banks. If you can't afford food, call **0808 208 2138**, Mon-Fri, 10am-4pm. You can speak in confidence to a trained Citizen's Advice worker and they can issue you with a voucher code. Alternatively, you can get a voucher code from a referral agency. (E.g. doctor, health visitor, social worker, advice worker, police, children's centre, etc.) They will forward the code and your contact details to the food bank. The food bank will deliver food to you. Contact your nearest food bank for a list of voucher holders.
